

Wreaths Across America is on December 13, 2025

Red Oak Grove Church and Cemetery is proud to offer the 11th Wreaths Across America Service on December 13th at 11:30 am. This remembrance service is an extension of the national ceremony which takes place in Arlington National Cemetery on the second or third Saturday each December. We will start our celebration to honor Veterans indoors at Red Oak Grove Church. An Iowa Veteran will personally speak about firsthand experiences while serving in the US Military. The branches of the military will be honored with wreaths and military flags of their branches as they are displayed at the front of the church.

Names of all Veterans buried or commemorated at Red Oak Grove Cemetery will also be honored by having their names read aloud individually. The service will then move outdoors so that



family and friends can place a live, Balsam fir wreath with a bright red bow on each Veterans' grave. Roy Morris (US Army) shown in the photo was saluting and thanking a local veteran during the 2024 Wreaths Across America gathering. The morning will end with cookies, cocoa, and conversation in the church basement. This is a wonderful way to remember and pay homage to Cedar County veterans this holiday season.


Activities continued...
